DR. FLEMING OFFERS HER ADVICE ON AN EMERGING HEALTHCARE CAREER



Long-time CREED supporter, Dr. DaNine J. Fleming, wants our participants and their families to consider a career in the health professions, particularly Physician Assistant programs.

Dr. Flemings says "Physician Assistants (PA's) play a critical role in delivering high-quality, affordable health care. Based on current trends, this career is poised for tremendous growth, as our population ages and the number of physicians decline. PA's can essentially "write their own tickets" by balancing offers from numerous employers. There is also a critical need for PA's in rural and urban areas."

About the Profession...

Working under the direction of medical doctors, Physician Assistant's can:

•Provide diagnostic, therapeutic and preventive health care services in a team-based environment; •Specialize in family medicine, internal medicine, women's health, surgery, emergency care, and other specialties;

•Make diagnoses, perform routine care, and manage other team members; and prescribe medication.

She continues, "the role of the PA is truly diverse. Whereas one may work in a suburban clinic, another may spend long hours in surgery. Some provide home health services; while others gravitate to corporate settings. There is one constant thread that runs throughout the profession: patient-centered care."

"Depending on the specialty, the average annual salary can range from \$70,000 to over \$95,000. According to a study performed by CNN on the best jobs in America (2011), the position of Physician Assistant was ranked #2. I encourage you to consider the Physician Assistant career as a possibility for your future. It has been my pleasure sharing some insight with you and I am available if you have any questions."
